**Dear Mr. Berry:**

**This letter is in response to your request regarding the supply of rBST (BGH) free milk used in the manufacture of various dairy products at the Driftwood Dairy – El Monte, California plant (“Driftwood”).**

**All milk sold to Driftwood by Dairy Farmers of America (“DFA”) is produced at dairy farms that have signed affidavits acknowledging and agreeing that each producer does not use rBST (BGH).**

**If any producer decided to commence the use of rBST (BGH), then said producer is required by their agreement with DFA to provide DFA with thirty (30) days prior written notice of their intent to use rBST (BGH).**

**I am prepared to assure you to the best of our knowledge and belief, our producers are honoring their affidavits not to use rBST (BGH) and to the best of our knowledge and ability, when requested by Driftwood to do so, we are only supplying milk from dairies that do not treat their cows with rBST (BGH).**
